1808 George Stephenson built the first truly “industrial” locomotive for the Stockton & Darlington Railway in 1825, and named it “Locomotion” His more famous “Rocket” was built in 1829 to operate on the Liverpool and Manchester Railway – the world’s first passenger railway which Stephenson himself had been responsible for
